Safeguarding and Wellbeing

Mental Health Support—You may have noticed that visits to school by Lou Scott and Jasmine Francois from the Mental Health Support Team have been sadly lacking this year. This is due to funding cuts in Kirklees and this team being disbanded. School has always recognised the value that this type of support brings to our school, and community as a whole, and so we are now proud to share that we have subscribed to two new service providers. **Trustwellbeing** will provide support for parents/carers and **Keep In Mind** will provide support for pupils in school. There is a cost for both services, however this will be paid for by school and not passed on to parents.

Over the next term, Mrs Travis will be working with both providers to map out what events, education opportunities and resources can be used to best support all members of our school community. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to get in touch with Mrs Travis (who is mapping out the plan) or Mrs Morris, our very own Pastoral Lead. We look forward to working closely with both providers in the future.

Health and Safety—Just a few reminders to keep our children safe and happy at the beginning and end of school, when the entrance and school path can be a very busy place both with pedestrians and vehicles.

When queuing on the path, please **keep children with you at all times**. This is for their safety. The driveway is in constant use by vehicles and no one would want to see any harm coming to a child, who in their excitement of playing with their friends, runs from the path and in so doing collides with a vehicle arriving at school.

Also, please **don't leave dogs at the end of the path.** They can become anxious and act in a way that is out of character for them. Even the most friendly of family dogs can become frightened and make children nervous.
